Cities have also emerged as promoters of social agendas neglected or marginalised by national and international politics.

Against this background, EUARENAS investigates the ways in which social movements coupled with local government reform initiatives, manifesting themselves in local-level experiments, create momentum for political change that include more inclusive and participatory forms of governance.

In other words, EUARENAS responds to a major European challenge the need to strengthen legitimacy, identification and engagement within the democratic public sphere.

The systemic approach to deliberative democracy


The systemic turn in deliberative theory – while broadly accepted – is rarely empirically tested and discussed to identify its strengths and weaknesses.
